

EYFS	<p>Theme: Around the World Use cotton buds to do dot painting in the style of Australian Aboriginal art. Make collage animals using recycled materials Make Japanese folded paper fans Chinese writing African print making Use materials you have at home (buttons, beads, string, dried grains) to make mandalas</p> 	<p>Theme: On the Farm Handprint/ footprint farm animals Cotton wool sheep Mud painting Use ends of vegetables to print patterns</p>
