What are we learning this term?

There will be a focus on Inheritance in Science, which follows on nicely from our Evolution topic last term.  5 & 6 Statutory Word List and a set of ten spellings from the focus pattern that we are learning about that week.
- You will be expected to read regularly and record this in your Reading Journal. Both your reading book and journal need to be in school every day.

All of these tasks should be completed weekly by following Thursday.
