Sacrament of Confirmation

1.	Sacrament	An outward sign of an inward grace through which Christians share in God's love through the Holy Spirit. They are meeting points with God.
2.	Sacrament of Initiation	Confirmation is one of the three sacraments of initiation of the Church. The other two are Baptism and Eucharist (First Holy Communion)
3.	Confirmation	This sacrament recalls the Holy Spirit descending on the disciples at Pentecost. It is when a Christian becomes a full member of the Church.
4.	What happens during Confirmation?	In the Sacrament people are strengthened in faith through the power of the Holy Spirit, the gifts of the Spirit are increased.
5.	The Bishop	The Bishop usually administers confirmation. The Bishop extends his hands over the confirmands as a successor of the apostles. He says "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit."
6.	Spiritual change	During confirmation, the person is invited to live a life inspired by God's grace and the Holy Spirit
7.	Oil of Chrim	This is the oil of anointing. The anointing with chrim marks a Christian's total belonging to Christ.

1.	Holy Spirit	 <p>The Holy Spirit is God, as is the Father and as is Jesus the Son.</p> <p>The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity. God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit.</p>
2.	The gifts of the Holy Spirit	<p>These include:</p> <p>Wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude (courage), knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord.</p>
