## •What is the Phonics Screening Check?

- •It is a quick check of your child's phonics knowledge.
- •It is **not** designed to create any stress or anxiety for your child.
- •It assesses decoding skills using phonics.
- $\bullet$ It consists of 40 words (20 real words,

20 'alien words').

The children read the words on a 1:1 basis with a known adult.

If children do not achieve the required score in Year 1, they will retake the screening at the end of Year 2.

This year it will take place in the week beginning 9/6/25. Scan the code to see what a previous Phonics Screening Test looks like
