What We're Learning This Term



Some highlights are:

- French: The children will begin learning some simple greetings and useful words to start building their confidence with another language.

PE and Swimming

Our PE day this term will be on Tuesdays. On this day, children may come to school wearing their PE kit. Please ensure that no jewellery is worn on PE days for safety reasons. Swimming will also take place on Tuesdays, so children will need to bring their swimming kit with them each week.

Reading

Reading at home remains a vital part of your child's learning. We encourage all children to read regularly at home—both reading to an adult and listening to stories read aloud. This not only develops fluency and comprehension but also helps foster a lifelong love of reading.

Maths and Spelling

We will continue to work on strengthening children's basic maths skills. The Star Badges will be a fun way to celebrate progress in this area. We will also be focusing on spelling, particularly the Common Exception Words, to build children's confidence and accuracy in their writing.
