#### **Phonics**

Key Vocabulary -

**Phoneme** - The smallest unit of sound. There are approximately 44 phonemes in English (it depends on different accents). Phonemes can be put together to make words

**Grapheme** - A way of writing down a phoneme. Graphemes can be made up from 1 letter e.g. p, 2 letters e.g. sh,

**GPC** - This is short for Grapheme Phoneme Correspondence. Knowing a GPC means being able to match a phoneme to a grapheme and vice versa.

#### **Maths**

**Subitising** is the ability to tell the number of objects in a set quickly, without counting.

I know on a dice that 2 is different to 3 as 3 has a dot in the middle. I know 4 on a dice is arranged in a square and 5 is the same but has 1 more dot in the middle. 6 on a dice is arranged in 2 rows of 3.

Key apparatus we will use are:

Numicon, fingers, tens frame, tally, dice dominoes, cubes (I can spot them in the picture above)


