Key Vocabulary

Holy Spirit	The Holy Spirit is God, as is the Father and as is the Son. It is the Holy Spirit who fills creation, who spoke through the prophets, through whom Mary became the Mother of God, who descended on Jesus at his baptism and that freed the disciples at Pentecost.
Jesus	Is the Son of God, born into this world over 2000 years ago as a baby in Bethlehem. He is God who became man.
Pope Leo XIV	The pope is the leader of the Catholic Church. The first was Jesus' Disciple - Saint Peter. He lives in Vatican City. This is in Rome.
Pentecost	It was on Pentecost that the disciples experienced the Holy Spirit for the first time. It is celebrated 50 days after Easter.
Church	The word Church comes from a Greek word that means 'belonging to the Lord'. It can be a building where Christians meet to speak to God but it also means all people who believe in God. We are one Church.
parish	A small group of Christians, over one or two church buildings.
