

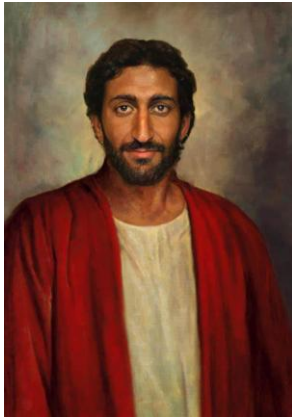
# EYFS RE Pentecost 2

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Christian	A Christian is someone who believes in Jesus Christ and follows his teachings. Christianity is the world's largest religion, with over 2 billion followers.
Faith	Religious faith, is a set of beliefs and practices that offer a way to understand the world, find meaning, and connect with something greater than themselves.
Judaism	Jews believe that there is only one God. They believe they have a special agreement with God called a covenant. Jews promise to obey God's laws to say thank you to him for looking after them.
Sikhism	Sikhism is the world's fifth-largest religion. The word 'Sikh' means 'learner' or 'seeker of truth'.
Islam	Followers of Islam are called Muslims. Muslims believe there is one true God Allah (the Arabic word for God).
Hinduism	Hinduism is over 4,000 years old, making it one of the world's oldest religions. It originated near the Indus River in India. The name 'Hindu' comes from the word Indus.
